# A Letter from Pastor Larry



## Greetings:

To All of My Dear Brothers & Sisters In Christ:

I hope that all of you are keeping up on the Lent daily reading list.

During our time of reflection and walking with Jesus, I want to ask you a question.

How is your prayer life? How often do you pray? When do you pray? Do you have any regular times that you pray? When do you pray more - when you need His help or

when things are going well? My experience is that we all feel we should pray more. We want to be closer to God.

Most of the time we look to the New Testament for answers about prayer. How does the Old Testament address prayer? Are there examples of prayer in times of joy, fear, want, and plenty? Are there prayers that petition God for provision?

The obvious answer is yes! There are many examples of prayer spread throughout the Old Testament. However, there is one particular section that is a literal goldmine of prayer. This section is the Book of Psalms.

The Psalms capture the entire realm of human experience, captured for all time for us to read, enjoy, and reflect upon. I invite all of you to explore this rich gift of scripture, to read and reflect upon.

The next time you are feeling your prayer life is suffering, turn to the book of Psalms. I know you will find words that you can identify with. Words of encouragement, lament, joy and even anger toward God.

Also, remember the Psalms are set to music and can be sung. Not only are the Psalms prayers, but also the first hymnbook! What does that tell us? We can communicate to God in spoken prayer as well as with a song.

God is our Father. As such, He loves to hear from His children. Let Him hear from you every day and in every way. Let Him hear from you today, as soon as you read this. Pick up your bible and peruse the Book of Psalms. Make it a practice to pray the psalms.

My prayer for you is that you will pray to the Father, from your heart. As His child, cry out to Him and let Him know how much you love and trust Him.

Psalm 146:2 - I shall praise the LORD all my life, sing praise to my God while I live.

Psalm 147:1 - How good to celebrate our God in song; how sweet to give fitting praise Enrich yourselves in prayer, praying unceasingly.


